- Hello, listening friends. 亲爱的朋友,你好,
- Welcome to this new broadcast. 欢迎你收听我们新的系列节目。
- We are bringing you a new series of messages from the book of Acts. 我们所要讲的新的系列信息,出自使徒行 传。
- I want to begin by relating this to a common occurrence.
 首先让我跟你谈谈一种很普通的情况,
- If you get summoned by the court to testify as a witness, 如果法院传唤你出庭作证,
- you will not be expected to present a legal argument, 你不需要讲一篇法律上的辩词,
- or to expound on some theory of jurisprudence, 或者讲解一些法学的理论,
- or to argue the finer points of the law. 或对法律的某个要点提出辩论;
- 9. When you are called to witness, 当你被传召作证人,
- you are only required to answer the following questions, 你只需要回答以下的问题:
- 11. what did you see? 你看见了什么?
- 12. What did you hear? 你听见了什么?
- 13. What did you experience? 你经历到什么?
- A witness may or may not know the law.
 一个证人可能懂法律,也可能不懂;
- 15. A witness may or may not know all of the circumstances surrounding the case.
 一个证人可能知道,也可能不知道有关这件 案子所有的情况;
- The witness might not be eloquent, 证人不一定能言善道,

- 17. or articulate. 不一定口齿伶俐,
- He is only required to tell the court what he saw and what he heard and what he experienced. 他只需要在法庭说出他的所见所闻,和他的 经历。
- Sometimes a witness's testimony can make a difference.
 有时候证人的证词,对案情有关键性的影响;
- Many times a witness' testimony can spare or kill a life.
 常常证人的证词,可以左右一个人或生或 死。
- Refusing to speak of what you know can ruin lives. 拒绝说出你所知道的,可能摧毁一个生命;
- Refusing to testify can place the lives of others in jeopardy. 拒绝作证,可能危害别人的性命。
- Jesus knew the importance of an eyewitness testimony.
 耶稣明白,见证人的证词多么重要,
- 24. That is why the last thing he said to his disciples was, "Be my eyewitnesses."所以他对他的门徒所说的最后一句话就是, 作我的见证。
- If there is one theme that runs through the book of Acts, 如果说使徒行传中有个贯穿全书的主题的话,
- it is the theme of witnessing. 那主题就是,作见证。
- In fact, Luke makes it clear that in his first volume, the Gospel according to Luke, 其实作者路加,在他第一集的著作,也就是 路加福音里,就很清楚表明了。
- 28. he documents the acts of the Lord Jesus Christ's earthly life and mission.
 他把主耶稣基督,在世上的生活和使命行动,都记录在案。

- And in his second volume, which is the book of Acts, he documents the acts of the Holy Spirit in the early church. 在他第二集的著作,也就是使徒行传里,他 记录了圣灵在初代教会的行动。
- The reason most Christians do not bear witness to their salvation, 为什么大部分基督徒,没有为所得到的救恩 作见证?
- 31. is because they think they can witness in their own strength.因为他们以为,要靠自己的力量作见证,
- While in reality, they can only witness in the power of Jesus Christ.
 但事实上,他们必须倚靠耶稣基督的能力才能作见证。
- My listening friends, I want you to listen to me very carefully.
 亲爱的朋友,请你很仔细地听我说。
- 34. There is a world of difference between testifying in your power and in Jesus' power. 靠自己的力量,和靠耶稣的能力作见证,是 截然不同的。
- When you think you should stand by yourself witnessing for Christ, 当你以为是独自一人为基督作见证,
- you will be discouraged. 那么你就会感到泄气,
- you will be disappointed. 你会失望;
- But if you are standing in the power of Christ, 但如果你靠着基督的大能,
- He will speak through you, 祂会透过你说话,
- 40. He will give you wisdom, 祂会赐给你智慧,
- and above all, he will give you faith. 池更会赐你信心。
- And that is why the first eleven verses of the book of Acts are very important. 所以,使徒行传开始的十一节经文非常重 要,
- They tell us all that we need to know about our message,
 那里告诉我们,必须明白所要传讲的信息,
- 44. and about our witness to that message. 以及如何为这信息作见证。

- 45. If you have a Bible, please turn to the book of Acts, chapter one, verses one to eleven.
 如果你手头有圣经,请翻到使徒行传第一章 1-11节,请听我读。
- These first eleven verses from chapter one of the book of Acts, 使徒行传第一章的这 11 节经文,
- 47. are a historical document of the forty days between Jesus' resurrection from the dead and his ascension to heaven.
 这是记载耶稣从死里复活,直到四十天后升 天的历史实录。
- 48. Luke is telling us six things about these eleven verses.路加在这十一节经文里告诉我们六件事:
- 49. First, 第一,
- 50. our message is his person, 我们的信息就是耶稣这个人,
- 51. verses one and two. 在第一、第二节里。
- 52. Secondly, 第二,
- 53. His manifestation is our proof, 祂的显现就是我们的凭据,
- 54. verse three. 在第三节里。
- 55. Thirdly, 第三,
- 56. His might is our promise, 祂的能力就是我们的保证,
- 57. verses four and five. 在第四、第五节里。
- 58. Fourthly, 第四,
- 59. the Master's plan is our priority, 神的计画是我们首要的事,
- 60. verses six and seven. 在第六、第七节里。
- 61. Fifth, 第五,
- 62. our mission is his program, 我们的使命是祂企划的,
- 63. verse eight. 在第八节里。

- 64. Number six, 第六,
- 65. our motivation is the prospect of his return. 我们的动机,就是对祂再回来的盼望,
- 66. verses nine to eleven. 在九到十一节里。
- 67. Let's look at the first one, 让我们来看第一点,
- our message is his person. 我们的信息就是耶稣这个人。
- 69. The Christian faith is the only faith where the message is the messenger.
 唯有基督教的信仰,信息本身就是传讲信息者。
- 70. If you take Jesus out of Christianity, 如果基督教没有耶稣,
- you will have nothing but a dead corpse.
 就全是空谈,和一具尸体。
- 72. Jesus did not merely teach about God, 耶稣不仅仅教导有关神的事,
- He was God. 祂自己就是神。
- Jesus did not merely tell us about salvation, 耶稣不仅告诉我们什么是救恩,
- He is our salvation. 祂自己就是我们的救恩。
- Jesus did not merely tell us about the wages of our sins, 耶稣不仅告诉我们什么是罪的工价,
- He carried those wages on his cross. 祂在十字架上亲自承担我们的罪价。
- 78. Jesus did not merely point us to God, 耶稣不仅指引我们归向神,
- He is the only way to God. 池自己就是通往神的唯一道路。
- 80. Our faith is not based merely on some dead words recorded in some dead book.
 我们的信仰不是建立在一些死的书本里的死 的字句上,
- 81. No. 不是!
- 82. Our faith is based on a historically proven, living, resurrected Christ.
 我们的信仰是建立在有历史根据,从死里复活,并且一直活到今天的基督身上。

- 83. Our faith is not merely a set of moral and ethical rules,
 我们的信仰并不只是一套道德伦理的规条,
- 84. but it is set in a personal God who empowers us.而是建基于使我们有能力的神身上。
- 85. He empowers us to live up to his moral and ethical standards.
 祂赐给我们力量,使我们的生活行为能符合 道德伦理的标准,
- So our message is his person.
 因此我们的信息就是耶稣自己。
- 87. Secondly, 第二,
- His manifestation is our proof, 祂的显现就是我们的凭据,
- 89. verse three. 在第三节里。
- 90. I'm amazed at the intellectual dishonesty of some so-called historians.
 我感到很讶异,有些声称为历史专家的学者,竟然在学术上不诚实。
- They would accept the detailed account of the eruption of Mount Vesuvius of AD 79 as historical fact, 他们对于公元 79 年,维苏威火山爆发情景的详细描述,完全接纳为历史事实,
- 92. even though it was written by a seventeen-yearold boy.而其实那是一个十七岁的男孩子所写的。
- 93. But they will refuse to believe the eyewitness account of at least five hundred people of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
 但他们却拒绝相信,至少有五百个目击证人,为复活的耶稣基督所作的见证。
- The resurrection of Jesus Christ is a fact of history.
 耶稣基督的复活是历史的事实,
- 95. And if you subject the resurrection to historical test, 如果让耶稣复活的事实,接受历史性的考验,
- it will pass with flying colors. 必定会通过无疑。
- 97. In Acts chapter one verse three, Luke tells us, 使徒行传一章三节那里,路加告诉我们,

- After his suffering Jesus showed himself to at least five hundred men, 祂受害之后,耶稣向至少五百人显现,
- and gave many convincing proofs that He was alive.
 并用许多凭据证明祂复活了。
- 100. Many of these eyewitnesses stood before the cross.
 这些目击证人中,许多都曾经站在十字架下,
- 101. They saw the nails going into Jesus' hands and feet.他们亲眼看见铁钉刺穿了耶稣的手和脚,
- 102. They watched him as he died. 他们眼看着祂死亡,
- 103. They saw him buried. 他们眼看着祂被埋葬,
- 104. But then they saw him alive again. 但后来他们看见祂复活了。
- 105. Many of them could not believe it. 许多人不敢相信,
- 106. But as they talked with him, 但当他们跟耶稣谈过话,
- 107. as they walked with him, 当他们与耶稣一同走路,
- 108. and as they ate with him, 他们与耶稣一同吃饭,
- 109. as they heard him speak of important issues of the kingdom of God, 他们聆听耶稣讲论关于神国度的重要性。
- they not only became convinced of his resurrection, 他们不仅确信耶稣的复活,
- 111. but they became willing to pay with their life for their conviction.
 他们更愿意为自己所相信的,付出生命的代价。
- 112. That is why, as a scientist, Dr. Luke uses words such as 'convincing proofs' 所以身为科学家的路加医生,使用"可信的 凭据"这样的字眼来说明。
- 113. What is the argument here? 他所提出的论据是什么?
- 114. A, 第一,

- 115. the resurrection of Jesus Christ is a fact of history.耶稣基督的复活是历史事实。
- 116.B, 第二,
- 117. because the resurrection of Christ is a fact of history, then he is the God of very God. 既然基督复活是历史事实, 祂必定是独一的 真神。
- 118.C, 第三,
- 119. and because he is God of very God, 祂既然是独一的真神,
- 120. everything he says is the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth.
 祂所说的每一句话,就必然是绝对的真理, 完全的真理。
- 121. D, 第四,
- 122. because he is the truth and everything he said was the truth, 既然祂就是真理,祂所说的也都是真理,
- 123. therefore, every human being will be judged based on whether they accepted or rejected the truth. 那么所有的人,就是根据他接受,或拒绝真 理来受审判。
- 124. Our message is his person. 我们的信息就是耶稣自己;
- 125. His manifestation is our proof. 祂的显现就是我们的凭据。
- 126. But thirdly, 第三,
- 127. in verses four and five, 在第四、第五节里,
- 128. His might is our promise. 祂的能力就是我们的保证。
- 129. The Scripture says, 圣经说,
- 130. that God's might is our promise. 神的能力是我们的保证。
- 131. If there is one thing that modern Christians do that runs contrary to the Scripture, it would be this.

如果说,现代的基督徒做了什么违背圣经原则的,应该就是这一件,

- 132. It is their overemphasis on methods and programs. 他们过分强调"方法"和"活动"。
- 133. I know that it is human nature to focus on this program or that program. 我知道,人喜欢把注意力放在不同的节目活 动上,这是人类的天性:
- 134. I know it is human nature to find a plan that has worked somewhere else and try to import it. 我明白,人类的天性总是喜欢把在别的地方 行得通的计画,搬回来使用。
- 135. That is why Jesus commands his disciples to wait on the Holy Spirit. 所以耶稣才吩咐门徒,要等候圣灵;
- 136. That is why Jesus commands his disciples to wait on the Holy Spirit. 所以耶稣才吩咐门徒,要等候圣灵。
- 137. In the Old Testament the Holy Spirit came to earth to accomplish a specific task, 在旧约时代, 圣灵来到世上完成某个特定的 使命,
- 138. and then he returned to heaven. 之后就回到天上去。
- 139. And that is why there are many promises in the Old Testament about the Holy Spirit's coming to earth. 因此在旧约圣经里,有许多关于圣灵要来到 世上的应许;
- 140. that one day the Holy Spirit of God will come to dwell permanently on the earth. 有一天圣灵要降临世上, 永远居住在其中。
- 141. And in Acts chapter one verses four and five, Jesus is telling the disciples, 在使徒行传第一章 4-5 节里, 耶稣告诉祂的 门徒:
- 142. to wait on the fulfillment of the permanent coming of the Holy Spirit before they witness. 在他们为祂作见证之前,要等待圣灵降临、 常与我们同在的应许实现;
- 143. Now two thousand years later, the Holy Spirit is here. 两千年后的今天, 圣灵仍然在这里。

144. And we know that no one can become a Christian without the power of the Holy Spirit. 我们知道,没有一个人可以不靠圣灵的能 力,成为基督徒的。

- 145. No one can receive Jesus Christ as Savior without the power of the Holy Spirit. 人没有圣灵的能力,就不能接受耶稣基督为 救主:
- 146. And that is why witnessing without the power of the Holy Spirit will produce no results. 所以,若不靠着圣灵的能力,作见证就不会 有任何结果。
- 147. Our message is his person. 我们的信息就是耶稣自己,
- 148. His manifestation is our proof. 祂的显现就是我们的凭据,
- 149. His might is our promise. 祂的能力就是我们的保证。
- 150. I want to tell you about the other three things in our next message. 在下一次的节目中,我要继续跟你谈其他三 方面。
- 151. I pray that you will come back and listen to the next broadcast because it's very important. 我祈求神,让你下次继续收听这个节目,因 为其中的信息很重要。
- 152. We will begin by talking about the Master's plan to be our priority. 我们会从「神的计画是我们首要的事」这一 点开始讲,
